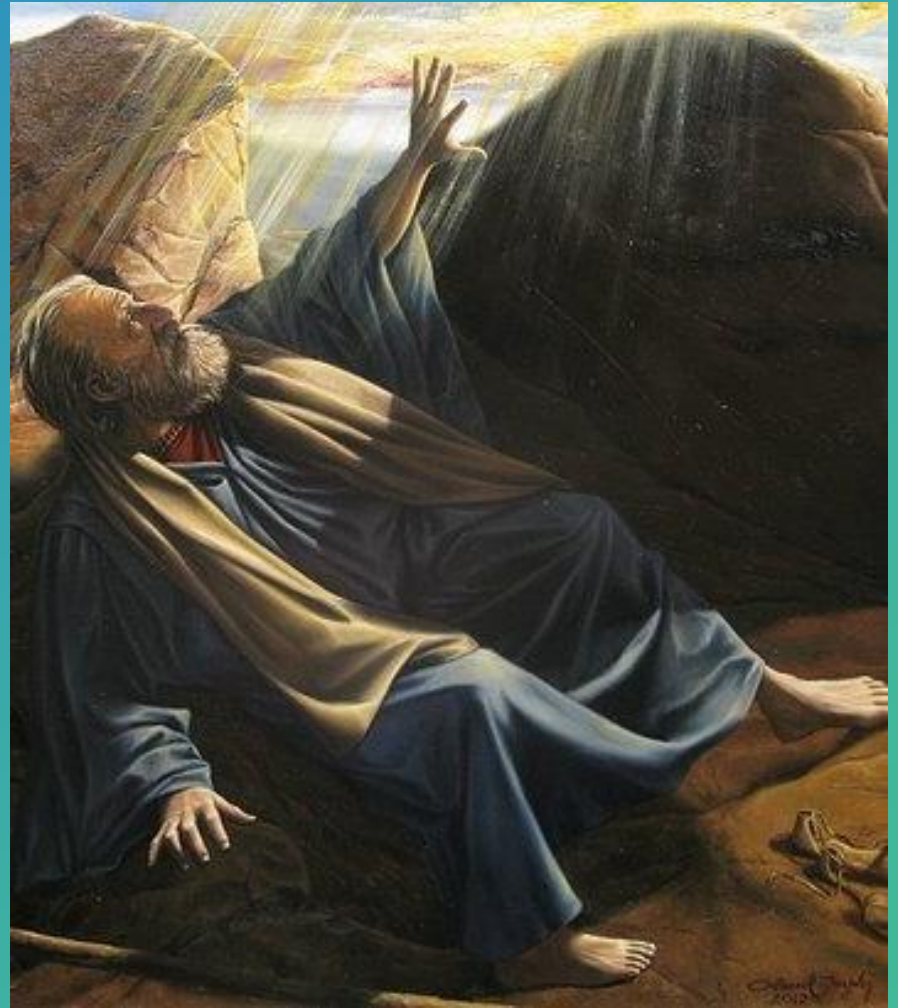

"LET ME SEE YOUR GLORY"

Slow to anger:
longsuffering,
Literally ***long nosed***

Exodus 34:6–7 (CSB) — 6 The LORD—the LORD is a compassionate and gracious God, **slow to anger** and abounding in faithful love and truth, 7 maintaining faithful love to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity, rebellion, and sin. But he will not leave the guilty unpunished, bringing the consequences of the fathers' iniquity on the children and grandchildren to the third and fourth generation.

SLOW TO ANGER

Exodus 32:19 (ESV) — 19 And as soon as he came near the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, **Moses' anger burned hot** [Lit. His nose burned hot], and he threw the tablets out of his hands and broke them at the foot of the mountain.



GOD IS SLOW TO ANGER

1 Peter 3:20 (CSB) — 20 who in the past were disobedient, **when God patiently waited** in the days of Noah while the ark was being prepared. In it a few—that is, eight people—were saved through water.

GOD IS SLOW TO ANGER

Genesis 15:16 (CSB) — 16 In the fourth generation they will return here, for **the iniquity of the Amorites** has not yet reached its full measure.”


