<sup>8</sup> I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob. I will give it to you for a possession. I am the Lord.' ” (Exodus 6:8)

<sup>43</sup> Thus the Lord gave to Israel all the land that he swore to give to their fathers. And they took possession of it... <sup>45</sup> Not one word of all the good promises that the Lord had made to the house of Israel had failed; all came to pass. (Joshua 21:43, 45)
