ISAIAH 6: THE NATURE OF GOD

- Nature of God "Holy, Holy, Holy is the LORD of Hosts..." 6:3; Rev. 4:8
- 25 times in Isaiah God is called "the Holy One of Israel" while the title is used 6 times in the rest of the OT combined
- Isaiah 57:15
- What does Holiness mean? How does it manifest itself?

ISAIAH 6: THE SINFULNESS OF MAN

- Man's sinfulness: "Woe is me for I am ruined..." 6:5
- Isaiah 1:4 "Alas, sinful nation, people weighed down with iniquity"
- Isaiah 5:18; 43:24; 50:1; 57:17; 59:1-2; 64:6-7

ISAIAH 6: GOD'S GRACE AND FORGIVENESS

- God's grace: "Your sin is forgiven..." 6:6-7
- Isaiah 1:18 "Though your sins be as scarlet, they will be as white snow, though they are red like crimson, they will be like wool"
- Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I..."
- Isaiah 27:9; 33:24
- Isaiah 53:5-6, 10-11 through Lord's servant

ISAIAH 6: MAN'S RESPONSE

- Man's Response to God's grace 6:8;
 Ps. 51:12-13
- We do not respond passively to grace. God's grace is not an excuse for inactivity, but it is a motive for service I Cor. 15:10; Eph. 2:8-10
